My single comment is comprehensive and not specific, as recommended by the Forest Service, yet it addresses a very specific threat to all forests, wild life, and recreational use in all 39 recommended wilderness areas and in all proposed plans.

In the interest of preserving a quality and reverence of life for future generations of humans and plants and animals, I endorse ALTERNATIVE D. If there were a more far-reaching designated area, I would endorse it for the simple reason that global warming now qualifies all future assessments of the natural world.
