If any part of the forest is completely closed off, then any roads for fire and rescue are the sole responsibility of the forest service.

There are groups in this state who will partner with the forest service and do "trail maintenance". But, those trails, even if they are not loops into or out of the forest need to be open for those groups to help maintain them.
