I believe that Montana's Custer Gallatin National Forest must be preserved, and that the following is necessary in order for the best outcome:

Wilderness recommendations in Alternative D should have added to it the entire 230,000 wild, roadless acres of the Gallatin Range as "Recommend Wilderness" in the final forest plan;

All motorized and mechanized activities and uses, including all those that are inconsistent with the protection of wilderness, should be prohibited until Congress can make a determination on the wilderness recommendations;

Group sizes of people should be limited to 12, and group sizes of animals should be limited to eight, as studies have shown that these limits better protect wilderness and forest;

Fish stocking in lakes which do not naturally have fish should be prohibited in order to preserve that natural conditions of the area;

Measures must be implemented to correct and eliminate contamination by human and animal feces of lakes and streams on the Beartooth Plateau in the Absaroka-Beartooth Wilderness.
