I am writing to let you know my thoughts regarding the management of Wilderness study areas and recommended Wilderness.

I would like to see them managed the same as designated Wilderness, so only foot and horse travel should be allowed. Motorized use would degrade the areas' unique character.

I am in support of protecting the Crazies to preserve their outstanding wilderness values and managing the area in close consultation with the Crow Nation.

I strongly support retaining the areas currently recommended for Wilderness in the Absaroka Beartooth area and additionally recommend Dome Mt, Emigrant Peak, Woodbine, East Rosebud to Stillwater, and Red lodge Creek for Wilderness.

I have spent a lot of time in the Crazies and the Beartooths and the Absarokas over the last 40 years. To lose their Wilderness status would be devastating to Montanans and to a world in which open roadless land is precious and rare.
