I am a retired medical provider living in Meagher County with long association with the Bozeman and Big Sky areas for the last three decades, who has spent many weeks each year traveling and camping in the CGNF, and the Beaverhead-Deerlodge and Helena-Lewis and Clark NFs. I urge you to manage all recommended wilderness areas as wilderness and allow only pedestrian and horseback travel in these lands. I support the Gallatin Forest Partnership accord, the current boundaries of recommended wilderness in the Lionhead area, and management allowing non-mechanized/nonmotorized travel only in the Tongue River Breaks and King & Cook Mountains. I also urge you to protect the following roadless areas: Line Cr Plateau, Red Lodge Cr/Hellroaring Plateau, N. Fork, Strawberry Cr, Chico Pk, Emigrant Mtn, and the Crazy Mountain range. All of these areas are familiar to me and are essential for wildlife habitat, hunting and fishing, for timber and grazing, as undisturbed watersheds, for dispersed foot and horse travel and quiet recreation.
